Welcome Back to the PSE Alumni Association

Over the last 5-10 years, the Phi Sigma Epsilon Alumni Assn. has lost track of many of its Alumni, for numerous and varied reasons. The primary reasons are related to moves without forwarding a change of address and unfortunately, the death of a Brother. There is also a long listing of alumni for which we have never had an address or disposition, many of them belonging to our older Brotherhood from the '30's through the '50's. The supposition can probably be made that there are a large group of deceased members in that group, but until we can confirm that, they are simply without an address. There are also many unknown addresses in our younger Brotherhood, primarily from the late '70's until our ultimate demise in 1986. These are more likely attributable to multiple moves over the years, as careers change or increased opportunity in a career has them making numerous geographical moves.

Many of you reading this Newsletter are probably reading it after having been absent from our address list for a long time. If so, Welcome Back! Your return to our Address List and Newsletter mailing was facilitated by finding an updated address for you

in the latest edition of the Eastern Illinois University Alumni Directory. I did purchase a copy last winter, for the express reason of tracking down changes of address and spent that time checking our address list against those listed in the new directory. The finding of at least 50-60 new addresses that we either had no address for or a different address listed, is the reason you are reading this for the first time in perhaps a long time. Is a PSE Alumni Logo'ed Polo Shirt in Your Future?

At the PSE Reunion Banquet last year, some ideas were floated around the dinner tables about the possibility of the Alumni Assn. providing a nice quality Polo-type golf shirt with the PSE logo on it. As I recall, there was even a list that was being circulated that evening to show interest in the idea. I have that list and another one generated later, that listed an initial interest in ordering about 50 of these shirts for those who have signed up. Although we've been a little slow in running with this idea, we are now offering it out to you to gauge your interest in purchasing one or more of these golf Polo shirts with the PSE Alumni logo silk-screened onto it. These pullover Polo-style shirts are a 50/50 cotton/polyester blend of fabric with a two-button neck adjustment and full collar. The color of the shirt is Birch (light gray) with a Cardinal (reddish burgundy) colored silkscreen of our logo on the left-chest area. The logo is comprised of our

Greek letters 1½" tall, with the word Alumni centered below it in ½" tall block letters. All of the normal range of sizes, from medium to 2X-large are available. The cost for this quality PSE Polo golf shirt is \$16.00 per shirt, which includes shipping costs. This is not a money-maker project for us; we are simply responding to an honest request to provide a product for which an interest was expressed. SIXTEENTH ANNUAL STUDENT AWARDS

It hardly seems possible that 15 years have gone by already since the inception of the PSE Alumni Assn. Student Awards in 1991, but this year's Awards will mark the SIXTEENTH year that we have given financial assistance.

As you may well know by now, the Phi Sigma Epsilon Alumni Association has embarked on an annual Student Awards program to financially assist identified children of former Phi Sigs (P.S.E., that is), Delta Chapter at Eastern Illinois University. The Association has been able to award grants totalling over \$43,000 the past 15 years.

With the receipt of this Newsletter, eligibility is open for you to submit to the P.S.E. Alumni Association, the names of children who will be attending EIU in Fall 2006 or those already in school as full-time undergraduates.

The cutoff date for submission of the Student Award Information questionnaire form in this Newsletter is July 15, 2006. Upon receipt and verification of children attending or about to attend EIU, notification will be forwarded to you regarding the Student Award. These awards will be presented on Sunday, August 20, 2006, in Charleston. Only one monetary award will be granted per family. This monetary grant is free of all payback and has no provisions as to how it must be used. Additionally, it is restricted by age to those 25 or younger and the PSE Board also reserves the right to make discretionary exceptions to the above-noted guidelines on a case-by-case basis.
